## HOUSE RULES

## "Bajka" Holiday Home of the University of Warsaw

- 1. Guests using the facility's services shall comply with the provisions of the present rules and regulations, together with OHS and fire safety regulations.
- 2. Check-in at the "Bajka" Holiday Home shall start at 14:00 on the day of arrival and check-out shall be done by 12:00 on the day of departure.
- 3. Persons arriving at the facility shall be accommodated on the basis of a referral and shall be subject to registration in accordance with the Act on Registration of Population and Identity Cards of 10 April 1974 (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2006, No. 139, item 993 as amended). The tourist tax must be paid immediately upon the guest's arrival (a local tax in accordance with the rates of the Resolution of the Dziwnów Commune Council). When checking in, please specify the preferred sittings of the board service.
- 4. Access and parking of vehicles shall be registered at the reception desk. Parking shall only be permitted in designated areas. The car park is not guarded or monitored, and the facility shall not bear any financial responsibility for damage to or theft of vehicles (the car park is free of charge).
- 5. Curfew in the entire facility is in force between 22:00 and 6:00, with the exception of events organised by the facility (previously announced).
- 6. The facility shall not bear any financial responsibility for losing money, securities, valuables or other objects, including those of scientific or artistic value.
- 7. The Holiday Home's guests can use the ironing room, gym, billiard room and bicycle rental (bikes are rented and returned on the same day with any faults reported to a designated facility staff member).
- 8. The facility provides fridges located in the corridors for guests' use, where they are required to place their groceries in their own labelled containers. Rules for the equipment use are posted on the fridges and available at the reception desk.
- 9. It is forbidden to take unfinished meals out on the facility's crockery (it is possible to take food away in your own containers).
- 10. Children remaining within the area of the facility, especially the playground, must be taken care of and supervised by their parents or other adults.
- 11. Animals are not allowed at the Holiday Home.
- 12. Smoking in the facility is strictly forbidden. The facility has designated areas where smoking is permitted.

- 13. It is forbidden to light a bonfire on the premises of the facility. There is the possibility of using your own barbecue in a designated area.
- 14. Holiday Home's guests shall be required to maintain order and cleanliness within their place of staying in the facility and, in particular, to dispose of their waste in a designated place (waste segregation).
- 15. The facility does not provide access to the Internet.
